Reindeer Hides

Since ancient times, the indigenous Sami people, who herd the reindeer, have been using every part of the animal for food, tools, clothing, storage bags and even hut building. Today, pelts are essentially a by-product of producing meat. These hides come from Scandinavian reindeer that have grazed freely in the Northern Arctic region of Lapland. These fine tanned reindeer hides are available in a standard version mainly used for decoration and a silcone treated version for added water resistance on the meat side. The coated hides can be used when camping, in a tent or hammock as well as just on a bench or chair in the garden. However be mindful that the secret of the warmth of reindeer hides is also their weakness - each hair is filled with what can be described as small air bubbles creating amazing insulation also making the hair sensitive to breakage and shedding. Because of this, it is not recommended to walk on reindeer hides and using them outdoors

It is also recommended that you avoid leaving the hides in humid conditions for long. After use outdoors and when stored, it should be allowed to dry and preferably be rolled out with the hair down to allow air to reach all parts of the hide - this helps prevent shedding. The colouring can vary from almost white to darkish brown. Approx dimensions are 100-120cm long by 60-100cm wide.
